

Course Tutors: Bruce Windwood

Bruce is a multi-award-winning film producer, with credits including the international comedy feature film 12 In A Box starring Miranda Hart and Katy Wix. Bruce is also an actor, writer and director for both TV and audio as well as a composer for the screen.

Bruce teaches filmmaking at the National Film & TV School, Oxford Royale Academy and Film Oxford. He also teaches on the Foundation Course at the Oxford School of Drama.

Course Overview

Thinking about a career in filmmaking?

This programme will immerse you in the world of **short film creation**, equipping you with the skills and knowledge to bring your stories to life. You will learn from **industry professionals** and **Oxford School of Drama tutors** whilst collaborating with other students on the course.

This course will provide you with a better understanding and knowledge of the **filmmaking and script-writing skills** you need to create short films. Through a combination **of talks, practical workshops,** and **hands on experience of shooting**, you will follow the production process from script-to-screen and create a short piece of **shot content**, that will be screened at a **showcase and celebration** on the last day.

What will the course cover?

The course will cover the following topics:

- Writing for screen
- Visual storytelling
- Producing short films
- Pre-production including casting
- Planning and scheduling
- Production including 'The Shoot'
- Working with actors and crew
- Post-production including editing and using software like Final Cut Pro
- Showcase and celebration
- Networking and Q&A event

On completion of the course students will be given a copy of the finished edited work.
